Eligible candidates are invited to submit articles addressing a thesis of importance in an area of intellectual property law from a Canadian or international perspective.

Categories

One winner will be announced from each of three separate author categories:

1. **Law student category**
(LL.B, J.D., BCL, and LL.L students)
2. **Graduate student category**
(LL.M, S.J.D. and PhD students)
3. **Professional category**
(legal and business professionals who have been practising 7 years or less, including patent agents and trade-mark agents)

Awards

1. Be awarded a prize of \$1000 (CAD)
2. Have his/her work published on the IP Osgoode website (www.iposgoode.ca)
3. Be considered for publication in the Canadian Intellectual Property Review and/or Osgoode Hall Review of Law and Policy (<http://www.ohrlp.ca/>)
